

# SuperStream

 – General information

## What is SuperStream?

SuperStream is a government reform aimed at improving the efficiency of the superannuation system.

Under SuperStream, employers must make super contributions on behalf of their employees by submitting data and payments electronically in a consistent and simplified manner.

## What is changing?

From 1 July 2014, self-managed superannuation fund (SMSF) trustees are required to receive both electronic messages and payment when employers make contributions using the SuperStream data and payment standard.

## What is required?

If you are an SMSF trustee, you will need an electronic service address to be able to receive data messages associated with employer contributions sent using SuperStream.

To help you obtain an electronic service address, the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) has published a register of SuperStream messaging solution providers that may be able to assist you. This register can be located on the ATO website.

You can use any service provider of your choice. The service provider list can be obtained from the ATO website.
